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## CEMENT IN OCTOBER 2021

This report provides monthly data on the shipments of cement to final customers and the production of clinker in the United States from January 2020 through October 2021. Data on the imports of cement and clinker for October 2021 also are provided.

Total shipments of portland and blended cement, including imports, in the United States and Puerto Rico in October 2021 were an estimated 9.9 million metric tons (Mt), a slight decrease from shipments in October 2020 (tables 2A and 2B). Shipments for the year through October totaled an estimated 89.7 Mt, a 3.5% increase from those for the same period in 2020. The leading producing States for portland and blended cement in October 2021 were, in descending order, Texas, Missouri, California, Florida, and Michigan (table 1A); these States accounted for 39% of cement origins. The leading cement-consuming States (Texas, California, Florida, Ohio, and Georgia) received 37% of October shipments (tables 2A and 2B).

Masonry cement shipments totaled an estimated 204,000 metric tons in October 2021, a slight decrease from those in October 2020 (table 2C). Shipments for the year through October totaled an estimated 2.0 Mt, essentially unchanged from those for the same period in 2020. The leading masonry-cement-consuming States in October 2021 were, in descending order, Florida, Texas, North Carolina, Tennessee, California, and Georgia; these States received 61% of October shipments (table 2C).

Clinker production, excluding Puerto Rico, totaled an estimated 7.4 Mt in October 2021, a 2.9% increase from production in October 2020 (table 4). Production for the year through October totaled an estimated 65.1 Mt, essentially unchanged from the same period in 2020. The leading clinker-producing States in October 2021 were, in descending order, Texas, Missouri, California, Florida, and Alabama (table 4).

Tables 5, 6, and 7 list import data from the U.S. Census Bureau; however, data for clinker imports into the Seattle, WA, and the Detroit, MI, customs districts do not include material trucked in from Canada on an informal-entry basis. Likewise, reported imports of cement into the El Paso, TX, district may be missing significant informal entries from Mexico. Monthly imports can show significant year-over-year changes for a variety of reasons and commonly do not correlate well with consumption levels in the respective import districts in the same month. October 2021 imports of cement and clinker, including Puerto Rico, totaled 1.8 Mt, a 10% increase from imports in October 2020. Imports for the year through October totaled 18.7 Mt, an increase of 31% from those for the same period in 2020.
