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COBALT IN SEPTEMBER 2016

U.S. cobalt consumption during January through September 2016 was slightly more than consumption during the same period in 2015. The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. imports of cobalt metals and chemicals in January through September 2016 was essentially unchanged from revised imports during the same period in 2015. The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. exports of unwrought cobalt and chemicals in January through September 2016 was 7% more than revised exports during the same period in 2015.

Prices

In September, the monthly average U.S. spot cobalt price increased for the third consecutive month. The monthly average LME cash mean price increased for the fifth consecutive month. The following listed prices are for cobalt metal in September, in dollars per pound.
