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COBALT IN NOVEMBER 2016

U.S. cobalt consumption during January through November 2016 was slightly more than consumption during the same period in 2015. The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. imports of cobalt metals and chemicals in January through November 2016 was 6% more than revised imports during the same period in 2015. The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. exports of unwrought cobalt and chemicals in January through November 2016 was 8% more than revised exports during the same period in 2015.

Prices

In November, the monthly average U.S. spot cobalt price increased for the fifth consecutive month. The monthly average LME cash mean price increased for the seventh consecutive month. The monthly average spot and LME prices were each

26% higher than those of January. The following listed prices are for cobalt metal in November, in dollars per pound.
