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## **COBALT IN DECEMBER 2016**

On the basis of preliminary data, U.S. cobalt consumption in 2016 was slightly more than consumption during 2015. The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. imports of cobalt metals and chemicals in 2016 was 12% more than revised imports during 2015. The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. exports of unwrought cobalt and chemicals in 2016 was 9% more than revised exports during 2015.

## **Prices**

In December, the monthly average U.S. spot cobalt price increased for the sixth consecutive month and was 38% higher than that in January. The monthly average LME cash mean price increased for the eighth consecutive month and was 36% higher than that in January. The following listed prices are for cobalt metal in December, in dollars per pound.
