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COBALT IN OCTOBER 2017

On the basis of preliminary data, U.S. cobalt consumption during January through October 2017 was essentially unchanged from consumption during the same period in 2016. The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. imports of cobalt metals and chemicals in January through October 2017 was essentially unchanged from that imported during the same period in 2016 (table 2). The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. exports of unwrought cobalt and chemicals in January through October 2017 was 27% more than that exported during the same period in 2016 (table 4).

Prices

Cobalt prices continued the upward trend that began in early 2016 as a result of strong demand from consumers, limited availability of cobalt on the spot market, and an increase in metal purchases by investors. In October, the monthly average U.S. spot cobalt price was essentially unchanged from that in September 2017, but was 126% higher than that in October

2016. The monthly average LME cash mean price was essentially unchanged from that in September 2017, but was 111% higher than that in October 2016. The following listed prices are for cobalt metal in October, in dollars per pound.
