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COBALT IN APRIL 2018

On the basis of preliminary data, U.S. cobalt consumption in January through April was essentially unchanged from consumption during the same period in 2017. The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. imports of cobalt metals and chemicals in January through April 2018 was 16% more than that imported during the same period in 2017 (table 2). The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. exports of unwrought cobalt and chemicals in January through April 2018 was nearly two times that exported during the same period in 2017 (table 4).

Prices

Cobalt prices continued the upward trend that began in early 2016 as a result of strong demand from consumers, limited availability of cobalt on the spot market, and an increase in metal purchases by investors. In April, the monthly average U.S. spot cobalt price was 4% higher than that in March 2018 and 63% higher than that in April 2017. The monthly average LME

cash mean price was 3% higher than that in March 2018 and 64% higher than that in April 2017. The following listed prices are for cobalt metal in April, in dollars per pound.
