## **COBALT IN SEPTEMBER 2018**

The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. imports of cobalt metals and chemicals in January through September 2018 was 5% more than that imported during the same period in 2017 (table 2). The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. exports of unwrought cobalt and chemicals in January through September 2018 was 59% more than that exported during the same period in 2017 (table 4).

### **Prices**

In September, the monthly average U.S. spot cobalt price decreased slightly from that in August 2018 and was 11% higher than that in September 2017. The monthly average LME cash mean price decreased slightly from that in August 2018 and was 4% higher than that in September 2017. The following listed prices are for cobalt metal in September, in dollars per pound.
