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COBALT IN FEBRUARY 2019

The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. imports of cobalt metals and chemicals during the first two months of 2019 was 20% less than that imported during the same period in 2018 (table 2). The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. exports of unwrought cobalt and chemicals during the first two months of 2019 was 39% less than that exported during the same period in 2018 (table 4).

Prices

In February, the monthly average U.S. spot cobalt price decreased by 18% from that in January and was 50% lower than that in February 2018. The monthly average LME cash mean price decreased by 18% from that in January and was 61% lower than that in February 2018. The following listed prices are for cobalt metal in February, in dollars per pound.
