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COBALT IN MAY 2019

The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. imports of cobalt metals and chemicals in May 2019 was 53% more than that imported in May 2018. For the first five months of 2019, the amount of cobalt contained in imports was 7% more than that imported during the same period in 2018 (table 2). The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. exports of unwrought cobalt and chemicals in May 2019 was 61% less than that exported in May 2018 and during the first five months of 2019, the amount exported was 51% less than that exported during the same period in 2018 (table 4).

Prices

In May, the monthly average U.S. spot cobalt price decreased slightly from that in April and was 64% lower than that in May 2018. The monthly average LME cash mean price increased slightly from that in April and was 62% lower than that in May

2018. The following listed prices are for cobalt metal in May, in dollars per pound.

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


Figure 1. Average U.S. spot prices and LME cash mean prices for May 2017 through May 2019. Sources: Platts Metals Week and London Metal Exchange.* *Corrections posted on June 16, 2020.
