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COBALT IN JULY 2019

The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. imports of cobalt metals and chemicals in July 2019 was 64% more than that imported in July 2018. For the first seven months of 2019, the amount of cobalt contained in imports was 6% more than that imported during the same period in 2018 (table 2). The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. exports of unwrought cobalt and chemicals in July 2019 was 59% less than that exported in July 2018 and during the first seven months of 2019, the amount exported was 50% less than that exported during the same period in 2018 (table 4).

Prices

In July, the monthly average U.S. spot cobalt price increased slightly from that in June and was 57% lower than that in July 2018. The monthly average LME cash mean price decreased slightly from that in June and was 61% lower than that in July

2018. The following listed prices are for cobalt metal in July, in dollars per pound.

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


Figure 1. Average U.S. spot prices and LME cash mean prices for July 2017 through July 2019. Sources: Platts Metals Week and London Metal Exchange.*
