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COBALT IN SEPTEMBER 2019

The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. imports of cobalt metals and chemicals in September 2019 was 82% more than that imported in September 2018. For the first nine months of 2019, the amount of cobalt contained in imports was 12% more than that imported during the same period in 2018 (table 2). The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. exports of unwrought cobalt and chemicals in September 2019 was 35% less than that exported in September 2018 and during the first nine months of 2019, the amount exported was 47% less than that exported during the same period in 2018 (table 4).

Prices

In September, the monthly average U.S. spot cobalt price increased by 18% from that in August and was 44% lower than that in September 2018. The monthly average LME cash mean price increased by 22% from that in August and was 42% lower than that in September 2018. The following listed prices are for cobalt metal in September, in dollars per pound.

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


Figure 1. Average U.S. spot prices and LME cash mean prices for September 2017 through September 2019. Sources: Platts Metals Week and London Metal Exchange.*
