COBALT IN MAY 2021

The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. imports of cobalt metals and chemicals in May 2021 was 9% more than that imported in May 2020. For the first 5 months of 2021, the amount of cobalt contained in imports was 30% less than that imported during the same period in 2020 (table 2). The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. exports of unwrought cobalt and chemicals in May 2021 was 58% more than that exported in May 2020. During the first 5 months of 2021, exports were 50% more than those during the same period in 2020 (table 4).

Prices




Figure 1. Average U.S. spot prices and LME cash mean prices for May 2019 through May 2021. Sources: S&P Global Platts Metals Week and London Metal Exchange.

In the first 5 months of 2021, the cobalt market experienced higher prices and lower London Metal Exchange (LME) stocks compared with those in 2020 (fig. 1, table 1). In May, the monthly average U.S. spot cobalt price decreased by 8% from that in April and was 32% higher than that in May 2020. The monthly average LME cash mean price decreased by 10% from

that in April and was 50% higher than that in May 2020. The following listed prices are for cobalt metal in May, in dollars per pound.
