COBALT IN DECEMBER 2021

The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. imports of cobalt metals and chemicals in December 2021 was 6% more than that imported in December 2020. In 2021, the amount of cobalt contained in imports was essentially the same as that imported during 2020 (table 2). The amount of cobalt contained in U.S. exports of unwrought cobalt and chemicals in December 2021 was 56% more than that exported in December 2020. In 2021, exports were 43% more than those in 2020 (table 4).

Prices




Figure 1. Average U.S. spot prices and LME cash mean prices for December 2019 through December 2021. Sources: S&P Global Platts Metals Week and London Metal Exchange.

In 2021, the cobalt market experienced higher prices and lower London Metal Exchange (LME) stocks compared with those in 2020 (fig. 1, table 1). In December, the monthly average U.S. spot cobalt price increased by 13% from that in November and was more than two times that in December 2020. The monthly average LME cash mean price was 15% higher than that in November and more than two times that in December 2020. The following listed prices are for cobalt metal in December, in dollars per pound.

The 2021 annual average U.S. spot cobalt price was \$24.21 per pound, 54% higher than the 2020 annual average price of \$15.70 per pound. The 2021 annual average LME cash mean price was \$23.17 per pound, 63% higher than the 2020 annual average price of \$14.21 per pound.
