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IRON ORE IN JUNE 1999

U.S. mine production of iron ore in June 1999 was about 10% lower than that of May 1999, according to the U.S. Geological Survey. Shipments decreased by about 5% and mine stocks

decreased by about 7%. Consumption data for May and June 1999 and trade data for June 1999 will be included in a subsequent issue.
