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MANGANESE IN MARCH 2002

In March, reported consumption of manganese ore containing 35% or more manganese, exclusive of that consumed at iron and steel plants, was estimated as 23,400 metric tons (t), which was an increase of about 13% compared with that for the previous month, according to the U.S. Geological Survey. The figure for March increases to 25,800 t

when estimates for annual respondents are added on the basis of 2000 data. Corresponding industry stocks of ore at the end of the month were 136,900 t, which includes an estimate for annual respondents on the basis of 2000 data. This was a decrease of about 4% from that for the previous month.
