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MANGANESE IN DECEMBER 2010

Preliminary reported data (gross weight) for December 2010 indicate that consumption of manganese ore containing 35% or more manganese, exclusive of that consumed at iron and steel plants, was 39,100 metric tons (t), according to the U.S. Geological Survey. This was 3% less than the amount consumed in November 2010. The amount of manganese ore consumed in the fourth quarter of 2010 increased slightly to 119,000 t from the amount consumed during the second quarter of 2010. The amount of manganese ore consumed during 2010 was 460,000 t. This was a 9% increase from the revised amount consumed during 2009 (422,000 t). Industry stocks of ore at the end of November 2010 were 206,000 t, which was a slight increase from those at the end of October 2010.

Data for U.S. manganese imports and exports for November 2010 are published in this issue. On a contained-weight basis, U.S. imports of manganese ore plus dioxide and manganese ferroalloys plus metal were 17% lower and 9% higher,

respectively, than those in October 2010. U.S. imports of manganese ore plus dioxide and manganese ferroalloys plus metal during the first 11 months of 2010 were 56% higher and 136% higher, respectively, than those during the same period in 2009 (table 1).

On a contained-weight basis, U.S. manganese ore and manganese ferroalloys plus metal exports for November 2010 were 161% higher and 282% higher, respectively, than those in October 2010. U.S. exports of manganese ore and manganese ferroalloys plus metal during the first 11 months of 2010 were 8% lower and 28% lower, respectively, than those during the same period in 2009 (table 1).
