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MANGANESE IN OCTOBER 2019




Figure 1. Monthly imports of manganese (Mn) ore from October 2017 through October 2019. Source: U.S. Census Bureau.

On a gross-weight basis, U.S. imports of manganese ore in October 2019 increased to 112,000 metric tons (t) from 16,000 t in September 2019 (fig. 1, table 5). Imports for the year through October totaled 357,000 t, 8% less compared with imports in the same period in 2018.




Figure 2. Average monthly spot prices for manganese (Mn) ore delivered to China from October 2017 through October 2019. Source: CRU Group.

In October 2019, the average spot prices for manganese ore deliveries to China were \$4.29 per metric ton unit, 36%–39% grade, and \$4.72 per metric ton unit, 44% grade (fig. 2, table 1). Compared with September 2019 prices, the 36%–39%-grade price was 13% less and the 44%-grade price was 14% less. Compared with the monthly average prices in October 2018, the

36%–39%-grade price was 36% less and the 44%-grade price was 33% less.
