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MANGANESE IN MARCH 2020




Figure 1. Monthly imports of manganese (Mn) ore from March 2018 through March 2020. Source: U.S. Census Bureau.

On a gross-weight basis, U.S. imports of manganese ore in March 2020 were 69,600 metric tons (t), an increase from 9,280 t in February 2020 (fig. 1, table 5). Imports for the year through March totaled 79,200 t, 11% less compared with imports in the same period in 2019.




Figure 2. Average monthly spot prices for manganese (Mn) ore delivered to China from March 2018 through March 2020. Source: CRU Group.

In March 2020, the average spot prices for manganese ore deliveries to China were \$4.03 per metric ton unit, 36%–38% grade, and \$4.30 per metric ton unit, 44% grade (fig. 2, table 1). Compared with February 2020 prices, the 36%–38%-grade price was 9% less and the 44%-grade price was 4% less. Compared with the monthly average prices in March 2019, the 36%–38%-

grade price and the 44%-grade price were each 34% less, respectively.
