#### **MANGANESE IN JANUARY 2021**




Figure 1. Monthly imports of manganese (Mn) ore from January 2019 through January 2021. Source: U.S. Census Bureau.

On a gross-weight basis, U.S. imports of manganese ore in January 2021 were 694 metric tons (t), a large decrease from 47,600 t in December 2020, but an increase from the 297 t imported in January 2020 (fig. 1, table 5).




Figure 2. Average monthly spot prices for manganese (Mn) ore delivered to China from January 2019 through January 2021. Source: CRU Group.

In January 2021, the average spot prices for manganese ore deliveries to China were \$4.59 per metric ton unit, 36%–38% grade, and \$4.78 per metric ton unit, 44% grade, 20% and 17% more, respectively, than the December 2020 prices (fig. 2, table 1). Compared with the monthly average prices in January 2020,

the 36%-38%-grade price was 7% more and the 44%-grade price was 12% more.
