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#### **MANGANESE IN MAY 2021**




Figure 1. Monthly imports of manganese (Mn) ore from May 2019 through May 2021. Source: U.S. Census Bureau.

On a gross-weight basis, U.S. imports of manganese ore in May 2021 were 644 metric tons (t), a decrease from 15,700 t in April 2021 (fig. 1, table 5). Imports for the first 5 months of 2021 were 23% less than those during the same period in 2020.

#### **Prices**




Figure 2. Average monthly spot prices for manganese (Mn) ore delivered to China from May 2019 through May 2021. Source: CRU Group.

In May 2021, the average spot prices for manganese ore deliveries to China were \$4.43 per metric ton unit, 36%–38% grade, and \$4.86 per metric ton unit, 44% grade, slightly less and 4% less, respectively, than the April 2021 prices (fig. 2, table 1). Compared with the monthly average prices in May

2020, the 36%–38%-grade price was 33% less and the 44%-grade price was 22% less.
