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MANGANESE IN AUGUST 2021




Figure 1. Monthly imports of manganese (Mn) ore from August 2019 through August 2021. Source: U.S. Census Bureau.

On a gross-weight basis, U.S. imports of manganese ore in August 2021 were 25,000 metric tons (t), 43% less than that in July 2021 (fig. 1, table 5). The leading source of manganese ore, >20%-<47% grade, was Mexico and for >47% grade was Gabon. Total imports of manganese ore for the first 8 months of 2021 were 31% more than those during the same period in 2020.

Prices




Figure 2. Average monthly spot prices for manganese (Mn) ore delivered to China from August 2019 through August 2021. Source: CRU Group.

In August 2021, the average spot prices for manganese ore deliveries to China were \$4.67 per metric ton unit, 36%–38% grade, and \$5.41 per metric ton unit, 44% grade, slightly less and slightly more, respectively, than the July 2021 prices (fig. 2,

table 1). Compared with the monthly average prices in August 2020, the 36%–38%-grade price was 15% more and the 44%-grade price was 34% more.
