MANGANESE IN OCTOBER 2021




Figure 1. Monthly imports of manganese (Mn) ore from October 2019 through October 2021. Source: U.S. Census Bureau.

On a gross-weight basis, U.S. imports of manganese ore in October 2021 were 45,700 metric tons (t), 23% less than the amount in September 2021 (fig. 1, table 5). The leading source of manganese ore, >20% - <47% grade, was South Africa and for >47% grade was Gabon. Total imports of manganese ore for the first 10 months of 2021 were 39% more than those during the same period in 2020.

Prices




Figure 2. Average monthly spot prices for manganese (Mn) ore delivered to China from October 2019 through October 2021. Source: CRU Group.

In October 2021, the average spot prices for manganese ore deliveries to China were \$4.69 per metric ton unit, 36%–38% grade, and \$5.45 per metric ton unit, 44% grade, both slightly more than the September 2021 prices (fig. 2, table 1). Compared

with the monthly average prices in October 2020, the 36%–38%-grade price was 14% more and the 44%-grade price was 25% more.
