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MANGANESE IN JUNE 2022




Figure 1. Monthly imports of manganese (Mn) ore from June 2020 through June 2022. Source: U.S. Census Bureau.

On a gross-weight basis, U.S. imports of manganese ore in June 2022 were 12,200 metric tons (t), 87% less than the 91,600 t of May 2022 (fig. 1, table 5). In June 2022, the leading source of manganese ore, >20%-<47% grade, was Mexico and the leading source for >47% grade was South Africa. Total imports of manganese ore for the first six months of 2022 were 20% more than those during the same period in 2021.

Prices

In June 2022, the average spot prices for manganese ore deliveries to China were \$5.15 per metric ton unit, 36%–38% grade, and \$7.26 per metric ton unit, 44% grade, essentially unchanged and 6% less, respectively, than the May 2022 prices

(fig. 2, table 1). Compared with the monthly average prices in June 2021, the 36%–38%-grade price was 8% more, and the 44%-grade price was 42% more.




Figure 2. Average monthly spot prices for manganese (Mn) ore delivered to China from June 2020 through June 2022. Source: CRU Group.
