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## PLATINUM-GROUP METALS IN FEBRUARY 2017




Figure 1. Engelhard monthly palladium, platinum, and rhodium prices for February 2015 through February, 2017. Source: Platts Metals Week.

The Engelhard average February prices for platinum, palladium, and iridium each increased by 4% and that for rhodium increased by 5% compared with average January prices (table 1, fig. 1). The average monthly price for ruthenium was unchanged during the same period. The iridium and rhodium prices were at their highest since 2013 and 2015, respectively, and the price increases were in response to strong industrial demand (Jonson, 2017).

Stillwater Mining Co. (SMC) (Billings, MT) produced 4,110 kilograms (kg) of platinum and palladium from its mines during the fourth quarter of 2016, which included 1,880 kg of palladium and 572 kg of platinum from the Stillwater Mine and 1,280 kg of palladium and 370 kg of platinum from the East Boulder Mine. In 2016, SMC's mines produced 13,070 kg of palladium and 3,890 kg of platinum, which were increases of 4% and 6%, respectively, compared with 2015. SMC recovered 5,260 kg of platinum, palladium, and rhodium from recycled catalytic converters during the fourth quarter. Recovery of platinum, palladium, and rhodium from recycled catalytic

converters totaled 20,800 kg in 2016, which was 21% more than that in 2015 and a record high for the company (Stillwater Mining Co., 2017).
