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PLATINUM-GROUP METALS IN MARCH 2017




Figure 1. Engelhard monthly palladium, platinum, and rhodium prices for March 2015 through March 2017. Source: Platts Metals Week.

The Engelhard average March price for platinum decreased by 4%, and prices for palladium and ruthenium increased slightly compared with average February prices (table 1, fig. 1). The average monthly prices for iridium and rhodium increased by 5% and 10%, respectively, during the same period. The daily price for rhodium was above \$1,000 per troy ounce for the first time since June 2015. The increased iridium and rhodium prices were in response to strong industrial demand (Jonson, 2017).
