PLATINUM-GROUP METALS IN JUNE 2017




Figure 1. Engelhard monthly prices for palladium, platinum, and rhodium from June 2015 through June 2017. Source: Platts Metals Week.

The Engelhard average June prices for palladium and rhodium increased by 9% and 4%, respectively, and the prices of platinum and iridium increased slightly compared with average May prices. The price of ruthenium was unchanged from that of the previous month (table 1, fig. 1). The prices of palladium and rhodium were 48% and 52% higher, respectively, compared with those in June 2016, and the price of platinum was 5% lower than that in June 2016.

Industry News

On May 4, 2017, Stillwater Mining Co. (SMC) (Littleton, CO), the only domestic platinum-group metals (PGM) mining company, announced that it had been acquired by Sibanye Gold Ltd. (South Africa) for \$2.2 billion (Stillwater Mining Co., 2016). According to Johnson Matthey, the acquisition of SMC by Sibanye Gold made the company one of the world's top four primary palladium producers (Johnson Matthey plc, 2017, p. 28; Stillwater Mining Co., 2016; 2017). In 2016, SMC produced 17,000 kilograms (kg) of palladium and platinum from its mines and recovered 20,800 kg of palladium, platinum, and rhodium from recycled catalytic converters. It conducted its mining operations at the Stillwater Mine located near Nye, MT, and at

the East Boulder Mine located in Sweet Grass County, MT. (See Platinum-Group Metals in February 2017.)
