## PLATINUM-GROUP METALS IN NOVEMBER 2017

Imports for consumption of platinum-group metals (PGMs) in November 2017 were dominated by platinum waste and scrap and palladium, which made up 50%, and 30%, respectively, of imports (tables 2, 3). Imports for consumption of PGMs were 524,000 kilograms (kg)\* during January through November 2017, a 91% increase compared with 274,000 kg\* during the similar period in 2016. The majority (97%) of that increase came from imports of platinum. For November 2017, the leading import sources for PGMs into the United States were Canada, Germany, and South Africa (tables 2, 3).




Figure 1. Engelhard average monthly prices for platinum, palladium, and rhodium from November 2015 through November 2017. Source: Platts Metals Week.

Compared with the average October 2017 prices, the Engelhard average November prices increased slightly for platinum and increased by 4% for palladium, by 3% for rhodium, and by 60% for ruthenium. The average price for

iridium was essentially unchanged between October and November 2017. The November 2017 average prices of palladium, rhodium, iridium, and ruthenium increased by 44%, 83%, 43%, and 216%, respectively, compared with those in November 2016. However, the price of platinum was slightly lower than that in November 2016 (fig. 1, table 1).
