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SODA ASH IN NOVEMBER 2004

Natural soda ash production in November was estimated to be 898,000 metric tons (t), 4% lower than the previous month's production, according to the U.S. Geological Survey. Ending inventories were estimated to be 301,000 t, 7% lower than the preceding month's inventories. Wyoming trona production in November was 1.37 million tons. Total production of chemical caustic soda was withheld to avoid disclosing company proprietary data.

Apparent consumption of soda ash in October was 474,000 t, 23% lower than the October 2003 level of 613,000 t. Exports and imports of soda ash in October 2004 were 367,000 t and 573 t, respectively.

The trends in cumulative soda ash statistics through October 2004, compared with those of October 2003, were as follows: production was 3% higher, imports 15% higher, exports 6% higher, ending stocks 5% lower, and apparent consumption 2% higher.
