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SODA ASH IN OCTOBER 2005

Natural soda ash production in October was 898,000 metric tons (t), 3% lower than the previous month's revised production of 923,000 t, according to the U.S. Geological Survey. Ending inventories were 307,000 t, 4% higher than the preceding month's inventories. Wyoming trona production in October was 1.32 million tons. Total production of chemical caustic soda was withheld to avoid disclosing company proprietary data.

Apparent consumption of soda ash in September was 561,000 t, 7% lower than the September 2004 level of 605,000 t.

Exports and imports of soda ash in September 2005 were 312,000 t and 270 t, respectively.

The trends in cumulative soda ash statistics through September 2005, compared with those of September 2004, were as follows: production was 1% higher, imports 44% higher, exports 3% lower, ending stocks 29% higher, and apparent consumption 2% higher.
