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TUNGSTEN IN MAY 2018

U.S. net production of intermediate tungsten products, including metal powder and tungsten carbide powder, was withheld to avoid disclosing company proprietary data.

The amount of tungsten contained in U.S. imports of selected materials in January through May 2018 was 21% less than that imported during the same period in 2017 (table 2). The amount of tungsten contained in U.S. exports of selected materials in January through May 2018 was 8% more than that exported during the same period in 2017 (table 3).

Prices

Prices for tungsten concentrates and ammonium paratungstate, as reported in Platts Metals Week, have trended upward since late April 2016. In May 2018, the monthly average price for ammonium paratungstate was 33% higher than that in May 2017, and the monthly average price for tungsten concentrates was 38% higher than that in May 2017. The

following prices for May 2018, in dollars per metric ton unit, were converted from short-ton-unit prices and rounded to the nearest dollar:

Ammonium paratungstate, U.S. free market:

Low—\$353/metric ton unit WO_3 (\$320/short ton unit WO_3)

High—\$397/metric ton unit WO_3 (\$360/short ton unit WO_3)

Concentrates:

Low—\$309/metric ton unit WO_3 (\$280/short ton unit WO_3)

High—\$364/metric ton unit WO_3 (\$330/short ton unit WO_3)
