TUNGSTEN IN AUGUST 2018

U.S. net production of intermediate tungsten products, including metal powder and tungsten carbide powder, was withheld to avoid disclosing company proprietary data.

The amount of tungsten contained in U.S. imports of selected materials in January through August 2018 was 8% less than that imported during the same period in 2017 (table 2). The amount of tungsten contained in U.S. exports of selected materials in January through August 2018 was 14% less than that exported during the same period in 2017 (table 3).

Prices

Weekly prices for ammonium paratungstate, as reported in Platts Metals Week, remained unchanged from mid-May 2018 through the end of August. The August 2018 monthly average price was 28% higher than that in August 2017. Platt's weekly prices for tungsten concentrates remained unchanged from midto late June through the end of August. The August 2018

monthly average price for tungsten concentrates was 31% higher than that in August 2017. The following prices for August 2018, in dollars per metric ton unit, were converted from short-ton-unit prices and rounded to the nearest dollar:
