## **TUNGSTEN IN MAY 2020**

U.S. net production of intermediate tungsten products, including metal powder and tungsten carbide powder, was withheld to avoid disclosing company proprietary data.

The amount of tungsten contained in U.S. imports of selected materials in January through May 2020 was 9% less than that imported during the same period in 2019 (table 2). The amount of tungsten contained in U.S. exports of selected materials in January through May 2020 was 42% less than that exported during the same period in 2019 (table 3).

## **Prices**

The May 2020 monthly average price for ammonium paratungstate was 6% lower than that in April 2020 and 23% lower than that in May 2019. Platts' weekly average prices for tungsten concentrates have remained unchanged since mid-December 2018. The following prices for May 2020, in dollars

per metric ton unit, were converted from short-ton-unit prices and rounded to the nearest dollar:
