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TUNGSTEN IN SEPTEMBER 2021

U.S. net production of intermediate tungsten products, including metal powder and tungsten carbide powder, was withheld to avoid disclosing company proprietary data.

The amount of tungsten contained in U.S. imports of selected materials in January through September 2021 was 5% more than that imported during the same period in 2020 (table 2). The amount of tungsten contained in U.S. exports of selected materials in January through September 2021 was 31% more than that exported during the same period in 2020 (table 3).

Prices

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


Figure 1. Monthly average prices for tungsten concentrate and ammonium paratungstate for September 2019 through September 2021. Sources: Argus Metals International and Fastmarkets MB.

The following tungsten price comparisons are based on Argus Metals International prices. The September 2021 monthly

average price for tungsten concentrate, ex works China, decreased slightly from that in August 2021 and was 35% higher than that in September 2020. The September 2021 monthly average price for ammonium paratungstate, European Union market, was essentially unchanged from that in August 2021 and was 47% higher than that in September 2020 (fig. 1).
