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TUNGSTEN IN DECEMBER 2021

U.S. net production of intermediate tungsten products, including metal powder and tungsten carbide powder, was withheld to avoid disclosing company proprietary data.

On December 31, 2021, the U.S. Government stockpile inventory of tungsten concentrates held by DLA Strategic Materials was 14% less than that on December 31, 2020. The inventory of tungsten metal powder was depleted in June 2021 (table 1).

The amount of tungsten contained in U.S. imports of selected materials in 2021 was 9% more than that imported during 2020. China remained the leading supplier of imported tungsten to the United States, accounting for 27% of all tungsten imports in 2021, compared with 33% in 2020. In 2021, the United States imported nearly five times more tungsten from Vietnam than in 2020. Vietnam became the second-ranked supplier of tungsten imports, accounting for 16% all tungsten imports in 2021 (table 2). The amount of tungsten contained in U.S. exports of selected materials in 2021 was 24% more than that exported in 2020 (table 3).

Prices

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


Figure 1. Monthly average prices for tungsten concentrate and ammonium paratungstate for December 2019 through December 2021. Sources: Argus Metals International and Fastmarkets MB.

The following tungsten price comparisons are based on Argus Metals International prices. The December 2021 monthly average price for tungsten concentrate, ex works China, was essentially unchanged from that in November 2021 and was 30% higher than that in December 2020. The December 2021 monthly average price for ammonium paratungstate, European Union market, was unchanged from that in November 2021 and was 46% higher than that in December 2020 (fig. 1).
